
RAYMOND GOLD ONORIOBE 'M' AGED 57YRS

COUNT 1: That you Raymond Gold Onoriobe 'm' and others now at large on the 10th of February, 2016 at about 100hrs at Irede Island of Lagos in Apapa Magisterial District did conduct yourself in a manner likely to cause breach of peace by publishing a provocative wrong stories in Vanguard newspaper of 10th of January, 2016 against Integrated Oil and Gas Nig. Ltd and hereby committed an offence punishable under section 57 (a & b) of Criminal Laws of Lagos State of Nigeria 2011.

COUNT II: That you Raymond Gold Onoriobe 'm' and others at large on the same date place and time at the aforementioned Magisterial District did conduct yourself in a manner likely to breach of peace by trying to incite the community against Integrated Oil and Gas Nig Ltd. By telling people in your community that it was due to the massive job carrying out at the site of integrated Oil and Gas that is causing their houses to crack and damage and hereby committed an offence punishable under section 166 (d) of criminal laws of lagos state 2011.

COUNT III: That you Raymond Gold Onoriobe 'm' on the same date, time and place in the aforementioned Magisterial District did conspired with others now at large attempted to extort the sum of N40, 000,000 forty million naira only from Capt. E. Iheanacho of Integrated Oil & Gas and thereby committed an offence punishable under section 301 (1) of Criminal laws of Lagos State 2011.

COUNT IV: That you Raymond Gold Onoriobe 'm' on the same date, time and place in the aforementioned Magisterial District did threatening violent one Capt. E. Iheanacho 'm' of Integrated Oil Nigeria Limited by saying you will deal with him ruthlessly if he commence work on Integrated Oil & Gas site at Tomaro Island and hereby committed an offence punishable under section 56 of Criminal Laws of Lagos State of Nigeria 2011.
