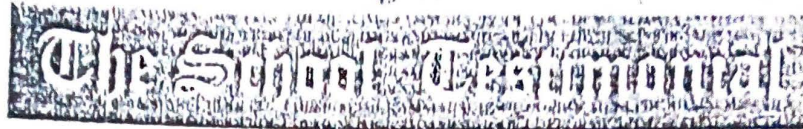

## **FOI: REQUEST FOR A CERTIFIED TRUE COPY OF ADEMOLA ADELEKE'S WAEC CERTIFICATE**

Warm greetings from the board and management of Say No Campaign Nigeria.

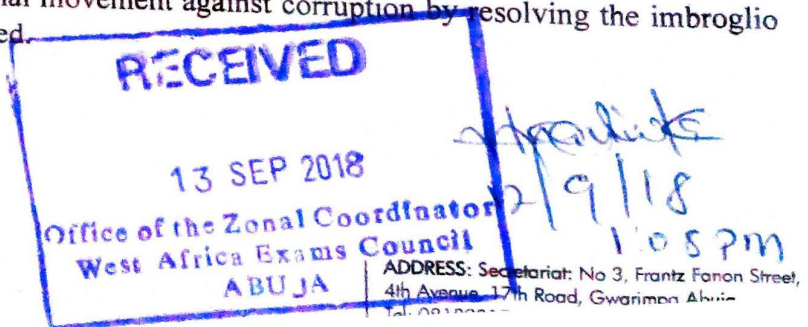
SayNo Campaign Nigeria is a platform of Nigerians committed to the fight against corruption, impunity and violence while advocating for transparency, accountability and justice in Nigeria. The Campaign is convened by Peering Advocacy and Advancement Centre in Africa (PAACA), YIAGA Africa, Civil Society Legislative Advocacy Centre (CISLAC) and Protest to Power (P2P).

By virtue of the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act, Say No Campaign writes the management of the West African Examination Council (WAEC) to supply a certified true copy of the WAEC certificate of Mr. Ademola Adeleke, to ascertain the authenticity of the presented SSCE statement of result for INEC screening.

The disparities between the presented statement of result and testimonial belonging to Mr. Ademola Adeleke, is glaring and cast obvious doubt on the authenticity of both documents. Beside the inconsistencies in the name of the schools and subjects taken, all, except one of the results, are pending, which is quite suspicious for an exam written in 1981 and collected in July 2018.

As a campaign, we do not believe that these discrepancies could have originated from a reputable organization like WAEC, and it is considering this that a clarification has become necessary. Should it have originated from WEAC, we are also hopeful that the examination body takes a stance as well.

Being an anticorruption campaign, which frowns at all manner and antics of corruption and invested in promoting transparency and integrity in leadership, we implore the WAEC board to show its support for the national movement against corruption by resolving the imbroglio caused by the documents presented.




**Thus, Say No Campaign is by this FOI, requesting WAEC to present a certified true copy of Mr. Ademola Adeleke's WAEC certificate to verify the authenticity of his certificate.**

The request is made in accordance with the provisions of section 1 and 2 of the FOI Act, which guarantees the right of citizens to seek information considered to be of public interest, from public offices.

Similarly, where the office cannot supply this information, section 5 **MANDATES** WAEC to direct the appropriate office to respond to this request.

While we await your required compliance with the provisions of the law, please be assured of our esteemed regards.

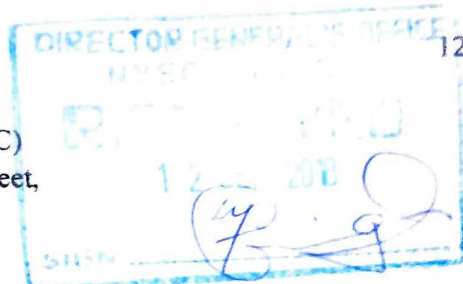

## **FOI: REQUEST FOR A CERTIFIED TRUE COPY OF KEMI ADEOSUN'S NYSC EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE**

Warm greetings from the board and management of Say No Campaign Nigeria.

SayNo Campaign Nigeria is a platform of Nigerians committed to the fight against corruption, impunity and violence while advocating for transparency, accountability and justice in Nigeria. The Campaign is convened by Peering Advocacy and Advancement Centre in Africa (PAACA), YIAGA Africa, Civil society Legislative Advocacy Centre (CISLAC) and Protest to Power (P2P).

By virtue of the provisions of the Freedom Of Information Act, Say No Campaign writes the NYSC to request for a certified true copy of the application letter of Exemption from NYSC submitted by Kemi Adeosun and the exemption certificate issued thereafter by NYSC to Kemi Adeosun.

As an anticorruption campaign that constantly seeks to promote transparency and good governance, we consider integrity in leadership to be sacrosanct. In addition, we maintain that public officials, especially those in critical position of trust are to live above board and be of reputable character althrough their service year.

In light of the above, the recent allegation that questions the authenticity of the exemption letter presented by Kemi Adeosun, purportedly issued by the NYSC, is worrisome to say the least. This, if not clarified, tends to undermine the anticorruption drive currently led by the Buhari administration which arguably portrays a zero tolerance to corruption.


Therefore, to put the rumours to rest and ensure that the finances of our nation is managed by a trusted individual, Say No Campaign invokes the FOI Act section 1 and 2, which guarantees the right of citizens to seek information considered to be of public interest, from public offices, to humbly request for the certified true copies of the following documents:

- 1. The signed letter of exemption submitted by Kemi Adeosun to NYSC**
- 2. The exemption certificate issued by NYSC to Kemi Adeosun**

Where the office cannot supply this information, section 5 **MANDATES** NYSC to direct the appropriate office to respond to this request.

While we await your compliant with the provisions of the law, please be assured of our esteemed regards.
