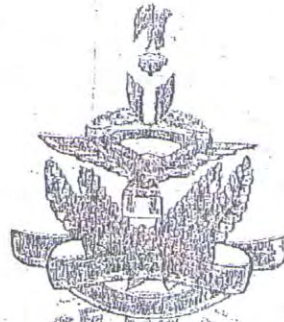

RE - REFERENCE - PLATFORM AMENDMENT AND ADDITIONAL CRITICAL ARMAMENT REQUIREMENT FOR THE NIGERIAN AIR FORCE

- B. TRIAX letter on Additional Critical Armament Requirement for the NAF.

1. The NAF hereby confirms the letters from TRIAX regarding platform amendment and additional armament requirement for the NAF vide References A and B (copies enclosed). This arrangement became necessary because the United States of America failed to endorse the sale of Cobra AH-1V attack helicopter to Nigeria. Accordingly, the NAF has agreed that TRIAX Nig Ltd replace the Cobra helicopter with 6 x upgraded armed Puma Helicopters, 4 x upgraded Su-25 KM and 2 x upgraded Su-25 UB attack aircraft.

2. The Technical Specifications and Scopes of Work for the aircraft types, required upgrade, training and support package as well as the additional armament requirements have been signed by both parties. These platforms are required in the short term to address the current national security challenges. As a long term solution, the NAF duly endorse the acquisition of new Mangusta 129 Attack Helicopters to enhance its operational capabilities.

REFERENCE -- PLATFORM AMENDMENT

A. Platform Procurement

This is to inform the National Security Adviser, in view of the U.S refusal of the export license to Nigeria, that Triax reached an agreement with the Nigerian Air Force to substitute the attack platform (Cobra AH-1) with the following equipment for a greater fire power and mission flexibility. The selected equipment will consist of:

1. 6 Upgraded Armed Puma helicopters with the equivalent attack capabilities of the Cobra, but with a greater fire power and operational range. The helicopters will have full navigation display system, enhancing the multi role of the platform. The equipment will be delivered with enhanced support package, training and spares for a period of 36 months of in country support.
2. 4 SU25 KM ground support/attack aircraft (upgraded to advanced attack and ground support). A training and support package will be included, as per the agreed SOW with NAF.
3. 2 SU25 UB (Training version), for the purpose of qualifying/transitioning of NAF pilots to the type/mission.

All within the previously approved budget in section A of your letter
Shipping of the platforms, Ground support equipment, Line replacement units and
spares to Nigeria – US\$ 14,850,000.

B. Armament

1. Within the approved budget the following ammunition were contained:
 - GATR smart tactical rockets (laser guided rockets 70mm, units 500)
 - MPR 500 bombs (500 LBs)
 - 20mm rounds and flare cartridges.

C. C-130

Periodic depot maintenance and EICAS upgrade for C130H, T56-15 RR engines for C-130H, "O"
Since shop visit/full QEC propellers for T56-15.


D. Building

Building a suitable proposed built storage and hangar for the Puma/Su-25 to accommodate the
GSE for the support of the Helicopters/Aircraft missions.

We humbly request, the National Security Adviser approval for the above NAF requested
changes.

As previously requested by the National Security Adviser, Triax had authorized the retention of
its deposit with Elbit to peruse the rapid implementation of the project.

REFERENCE -- ADDITIONAL CRITICAL ARMAMENT REQUIREMENT FOR NAF

1. NAF has requested additional armament for its current critical needs, for its other entire platforms (beyond the Puma Helicopter) including:

- S5 rockets (57mm 4000 units)
- S8 rockets (80mm, 400 units)
- FAB500 (500kg general purpose bomb, 500 units)
- Hydra 70mm un-guided rockets (20,000 Units)

Due to the requested qty. of the armament package, we are attempting to procure an advantageous price for this volume. We will provide a separate proposal in due course.

2. Three (3) C-130H Aircraft full avionic and navigation upgrade, tactical missions and international flight regulations compliance.

We are analyzing the engineering assessment of the final upgrade configuration submitted by NAF. We will provide a separate proposal in due course.

We humbly request, the National Security Adviser approval for the above NAF requested additions.
