NATIONWIDE MOBILIZATION FOR RE: NOTICE ON MON MODER ETUN WITHDRAWAL OF SERVICES

Please find as per the attached a copy of the circular of the Nigeria Labour Congress (NLC) in respect of the decision taken by the National Executive Council (NEC) of Congress which held today, Friday, 2nd June, 2023 regarding the hike in the price of petroleum products by the Nigeria National Petroleum Company Limited (NNPCL).

This circular is to direct the State Councils and the Branches of NASU to immediately commence mobilization and sensitization of all NASU members in the State Councils and the Branches for them to participate fully in the TOTAL STRIKE that will commence on Wednesday, 7th June, 2023, if the Federal Government does not respond positively to the demand of the NLC on the immediate reversal of the astronomical and obnoxious pump price as published by the NNPCL and already in effect.

The strike will be TOTAL and COMPREHENSIVE. Therefore, there will be no essential services and every single NASU member in all its areas of coverage is directed to fully participate.

#### **NUJ TO WITHDRAW SERVICES**

An emergency Central Working Committee meeting of the Union was convened online today, Saturday, June 3, 2023, to discuss issues surrounding the decision by the Federal Government to remove Fuel Subsidy and the position taken by the Nigeria Labour Congress.

After presentations by the National President, Chris Isiguzo, and the National Treasurer Bamidele Atunbi on the position taken by NLC on the matter, members unanimously adopted the position of NLC on the issue.

CWC reiterates the argument that although the removal of fuel subsidy will free allocations which can be channeled to the provisions of infrastructure and creation of additional jobs, the sudden removal could however lead to social unrests and protests as people may perceive Government as being insensitive to their plight.

CWC also notes that already there is an astronomical increase in the prices of petroleum products and high inflation which have drastically reduced the purchasing power of citizens.

Accordingly CWC directs all State Councils of the Union to mobilise members to withdraw their services and commence protests nationwide from Wednesday next week, 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2023, if the Nigerian National Petroleum Company Limited (NNCPL) refuses to reverse the new price regime in the oil sector.


